


The Varsity Basketball Team












This season more girls signed up for basketball than in previous years. The first team showed its ability by winning our second league banner for the year.










Volleyball is a very popular sport in our school. Many girls participated in after school intramurals which proved to be enjoyable. We came in second in league competition.

Our hockey team this year got off to a slow start but as the season progressed the tide changed. In the end it was very successful as evidenced by the banner which the honor team is proudly displaying.




