Congratulations, Seniors

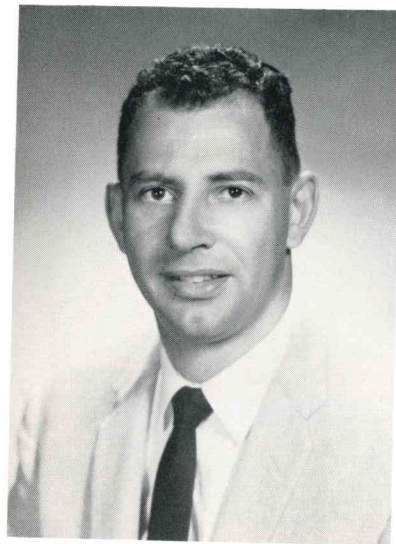

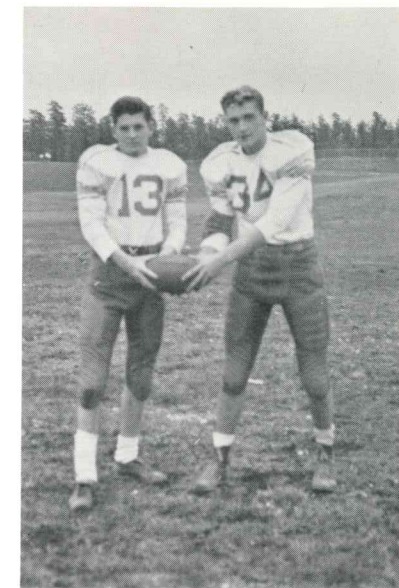
Football

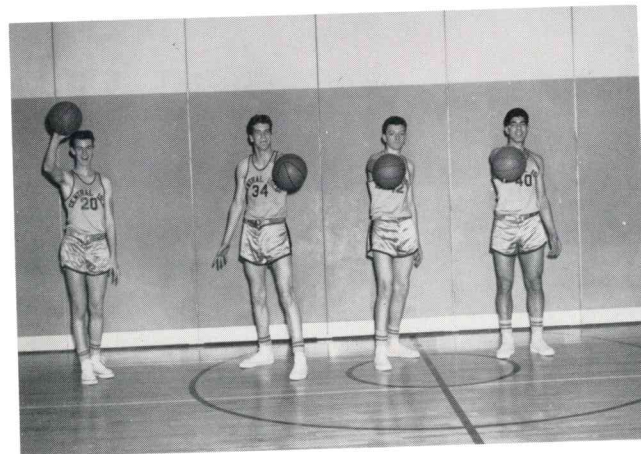

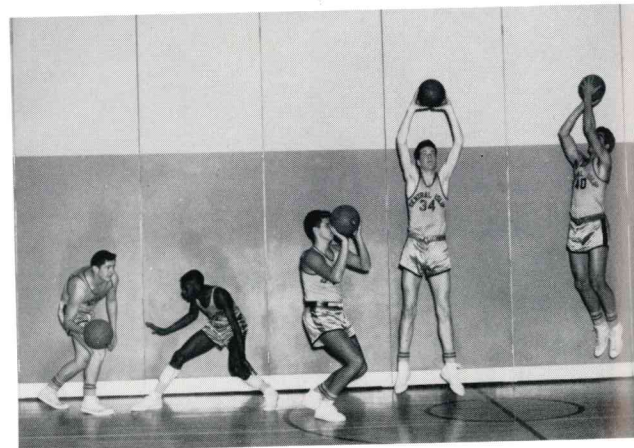


The Varsity Basketball Team

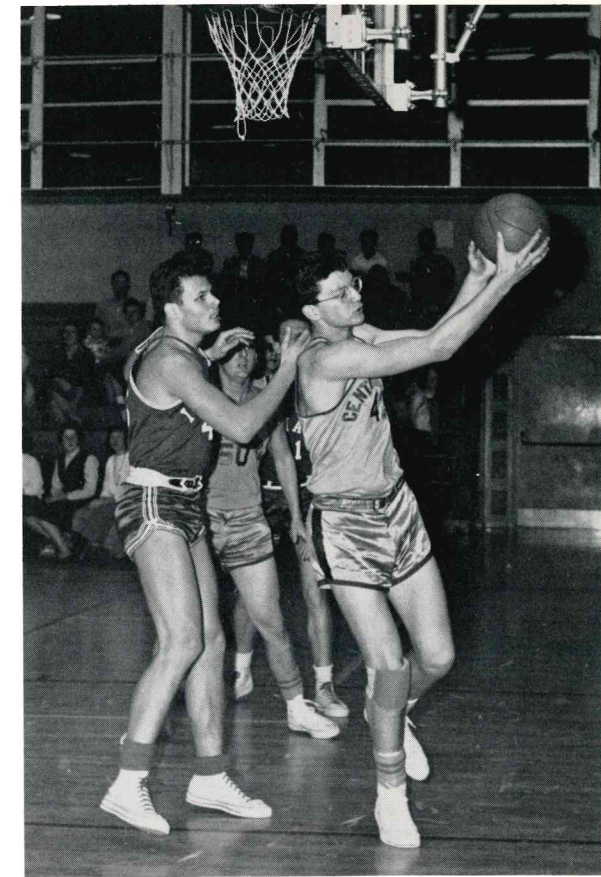

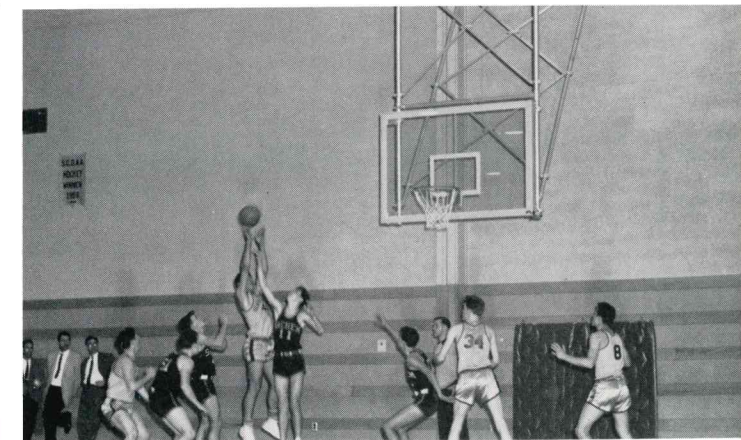

The Cross Country team completed its best season since becoming a varsity sport three years ago. The harriers, coached by Mr. Miller, were led by John Ashley and Ed Walters.

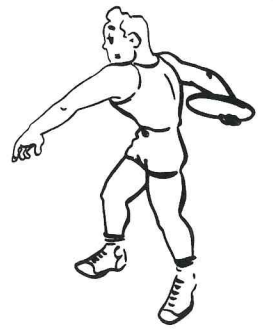

The Jayvee's did a credible job and some of the boys helped out the Varsity in several matches.

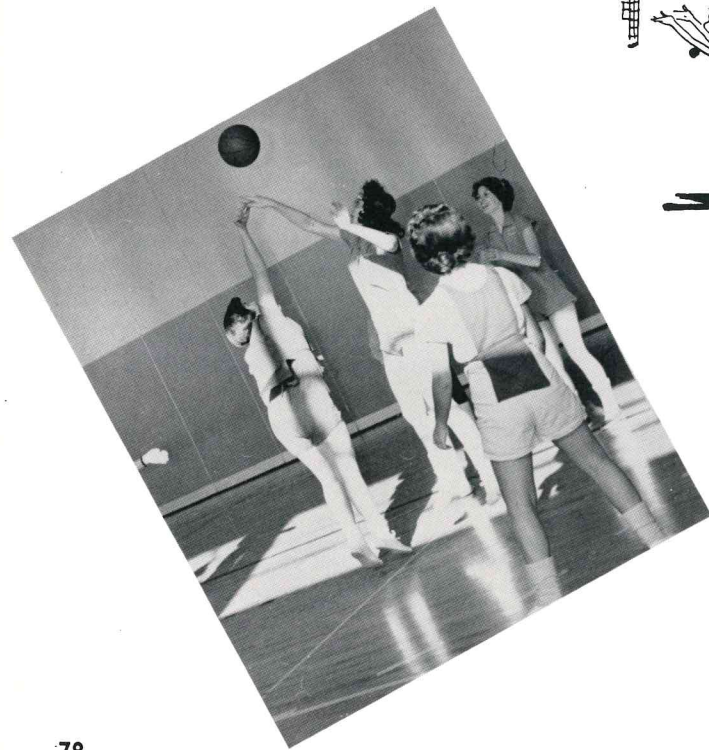




This season more girls signed up for basketball than in previous years. The first team showed its ability by winning our second league banner for the year.

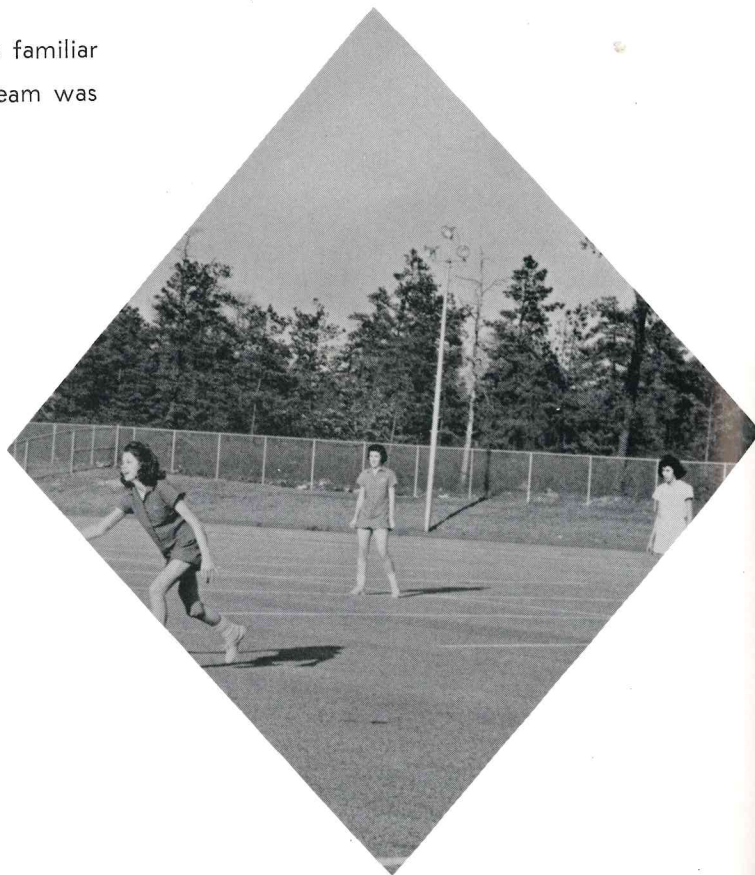


The badminton season is characterized by flying birdies and swinging rackets. Intramurals were held and to the "victor went the spoils."
