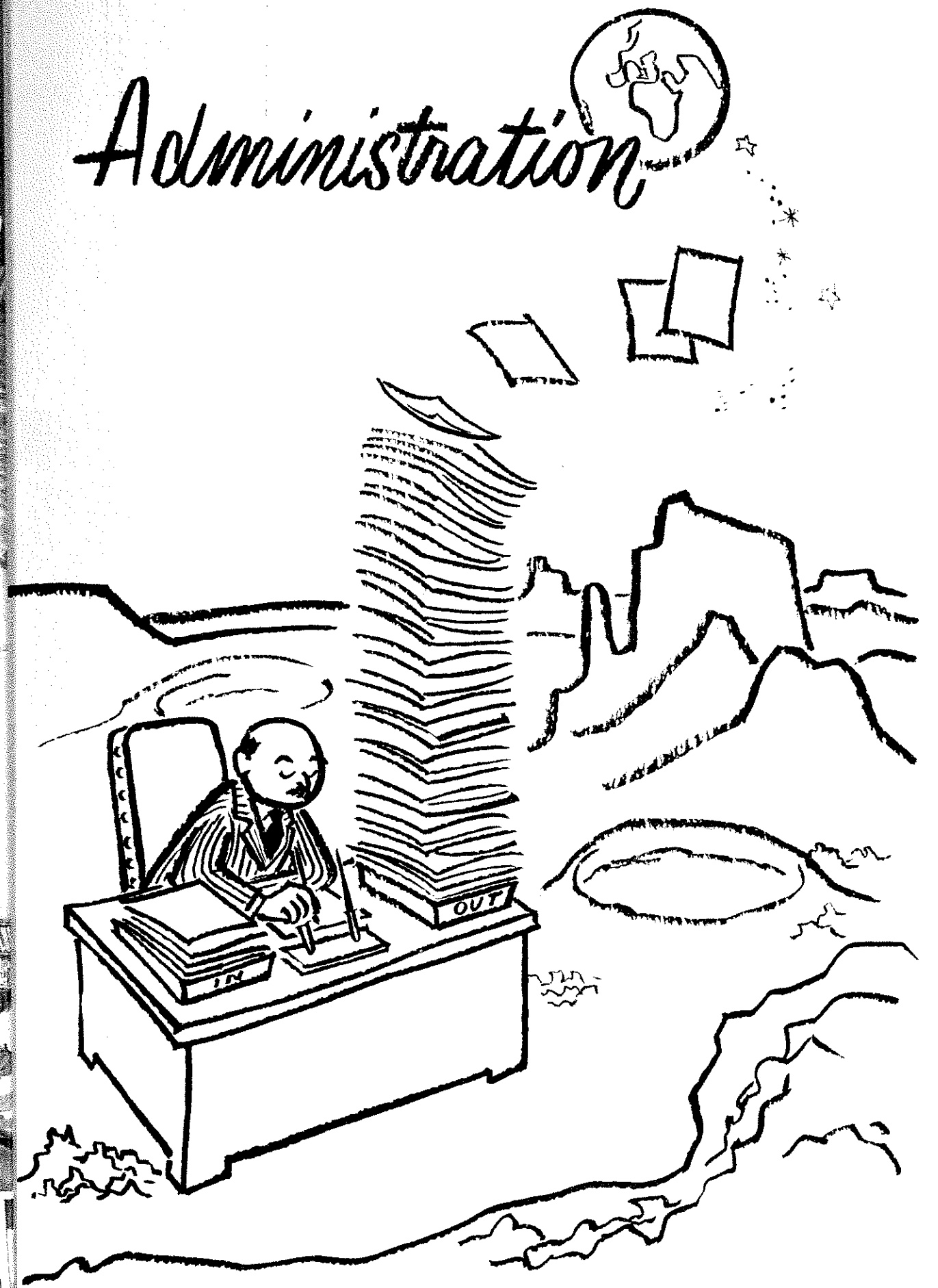
He has earned the respect of his faculty, fellow administrators and students.
