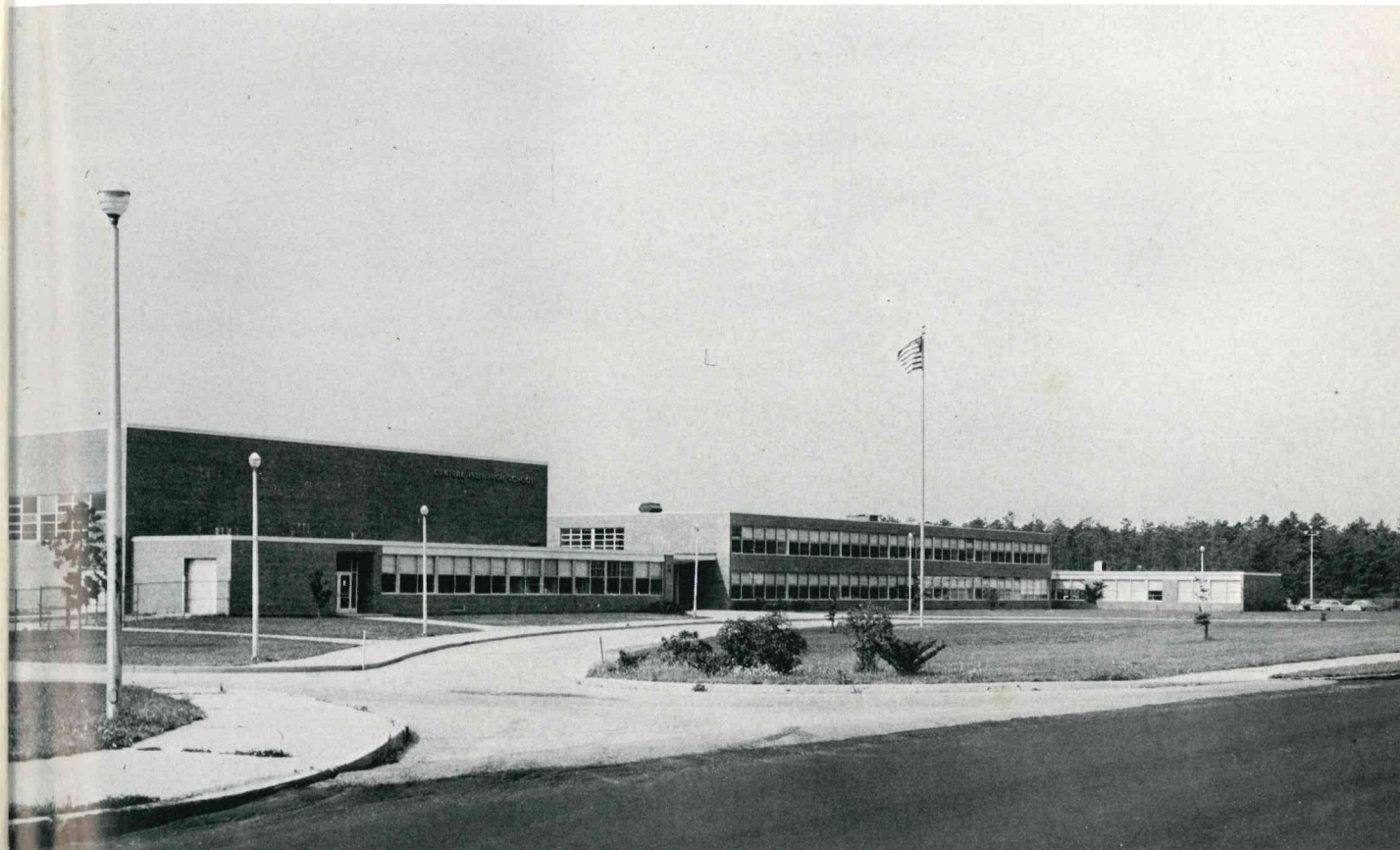

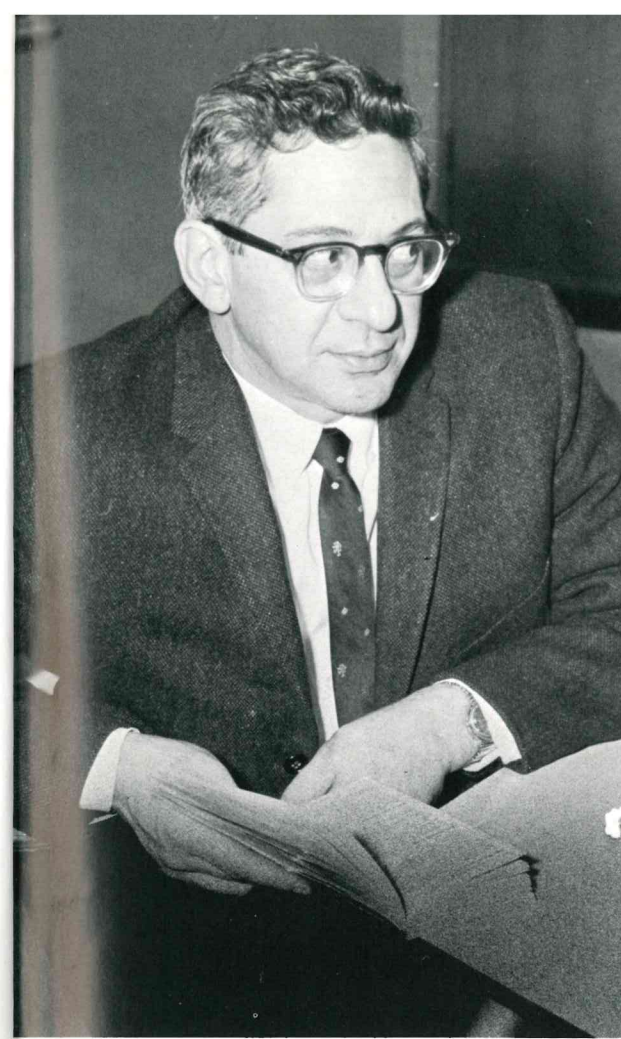
Yes, these memories are ever present now and as the memories fade with the years, my yearbook will serve as a constant reminder of that part of my life that I hold dear.
