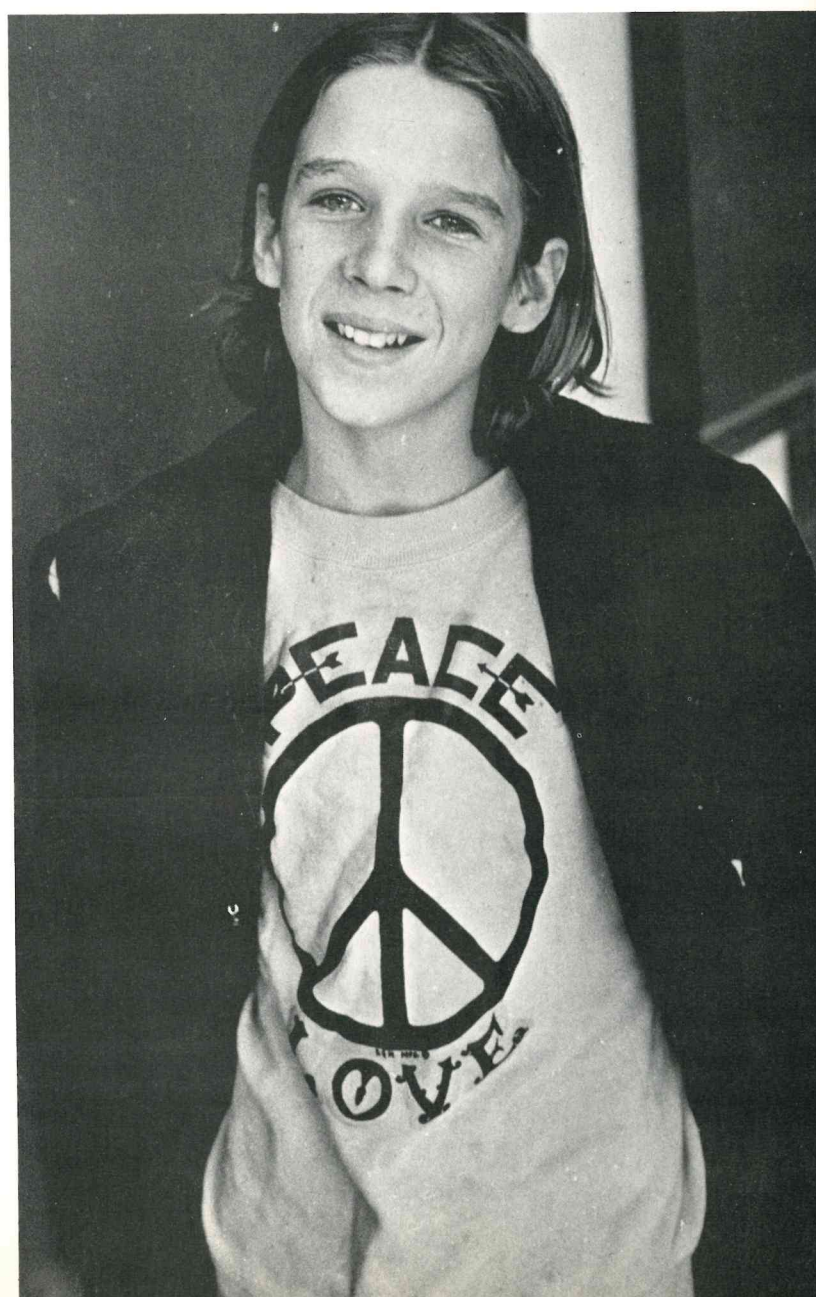




A great man once said, "True peace is not merely the absence of tension, but it is the presence of justice and brotherhood."
