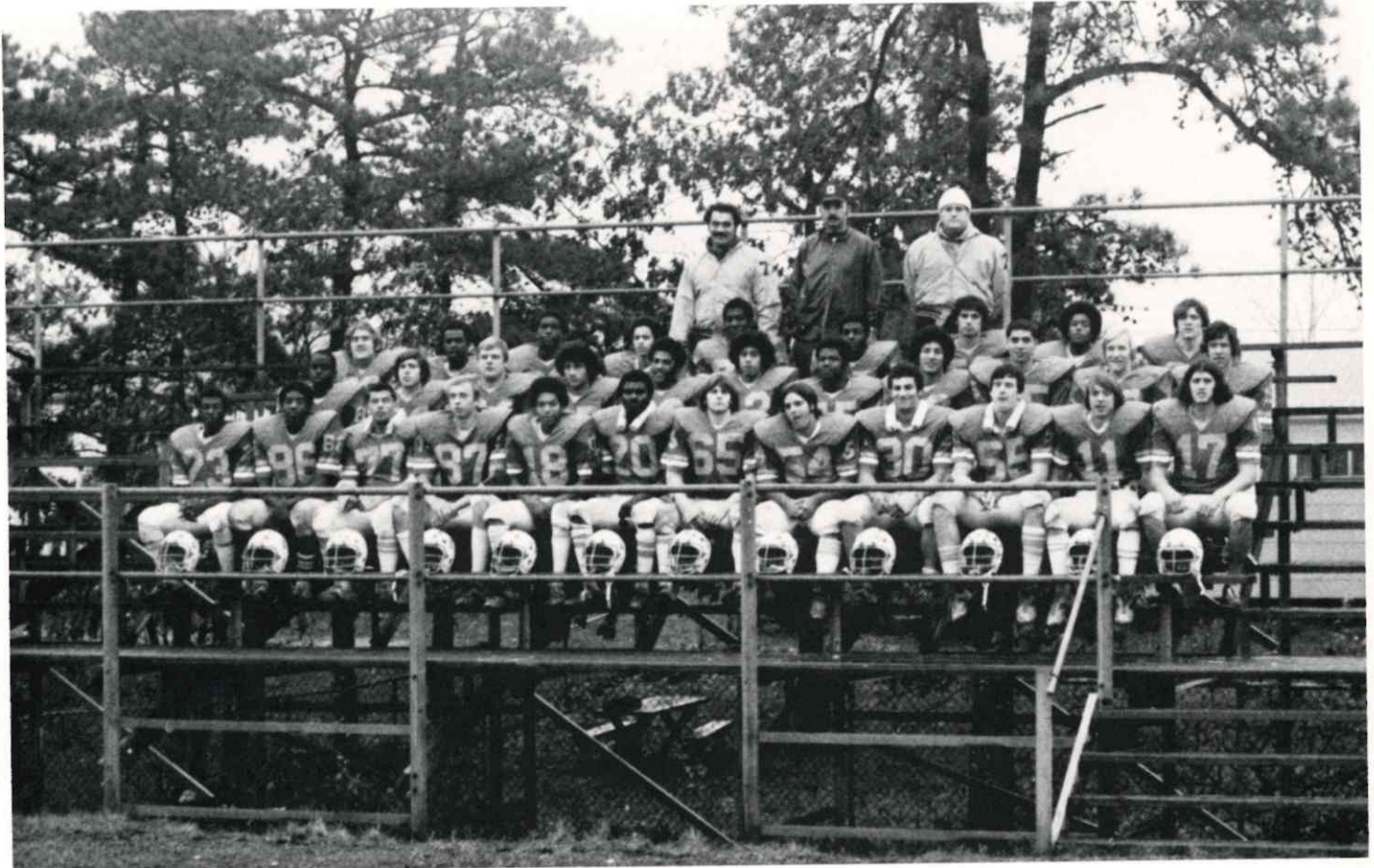
The first Coaches Relay Carnival started us on a season that kept us moving and improving. The final wins-losses record was 2-6 but some of those losses were just by a couple of points.
