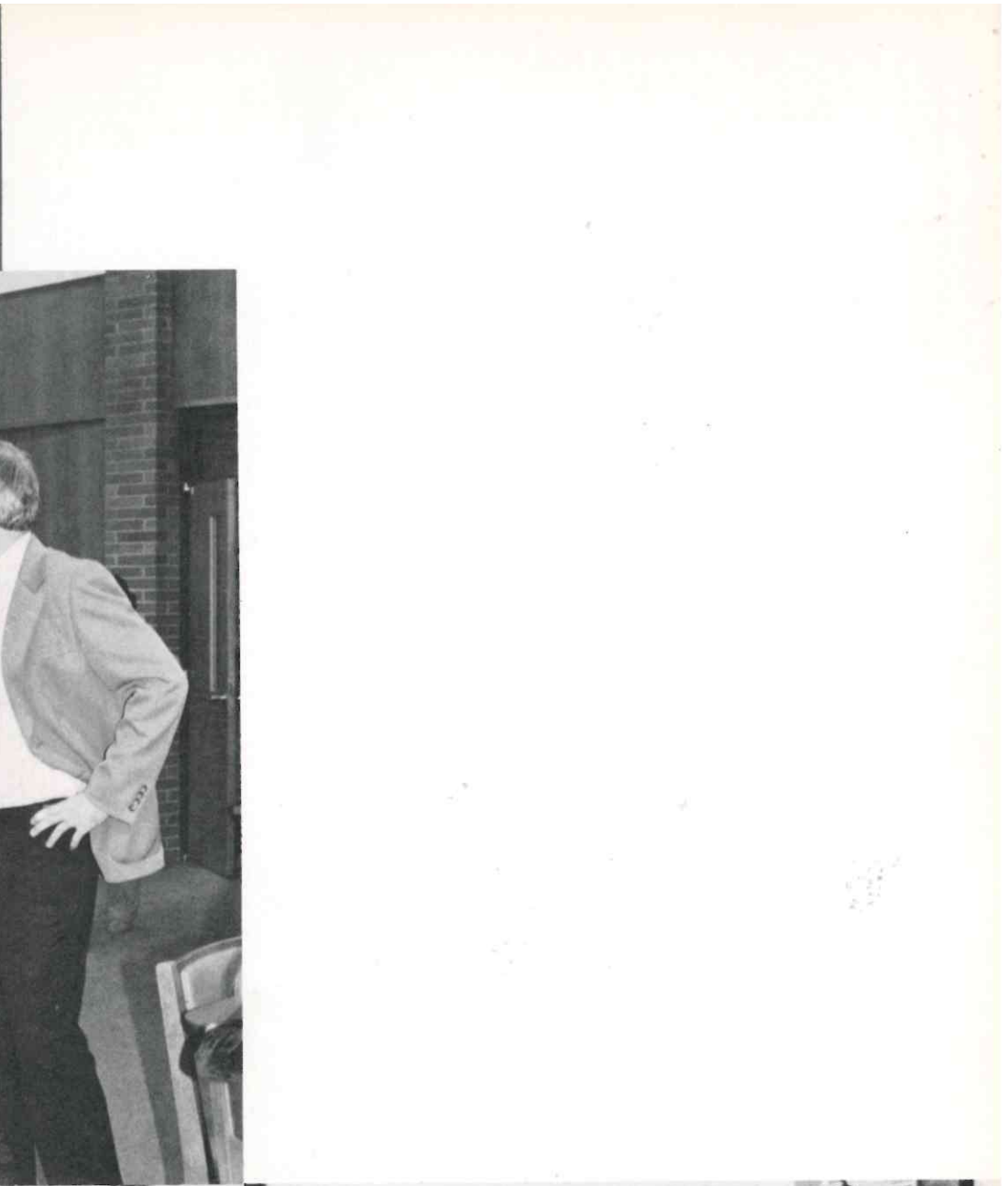
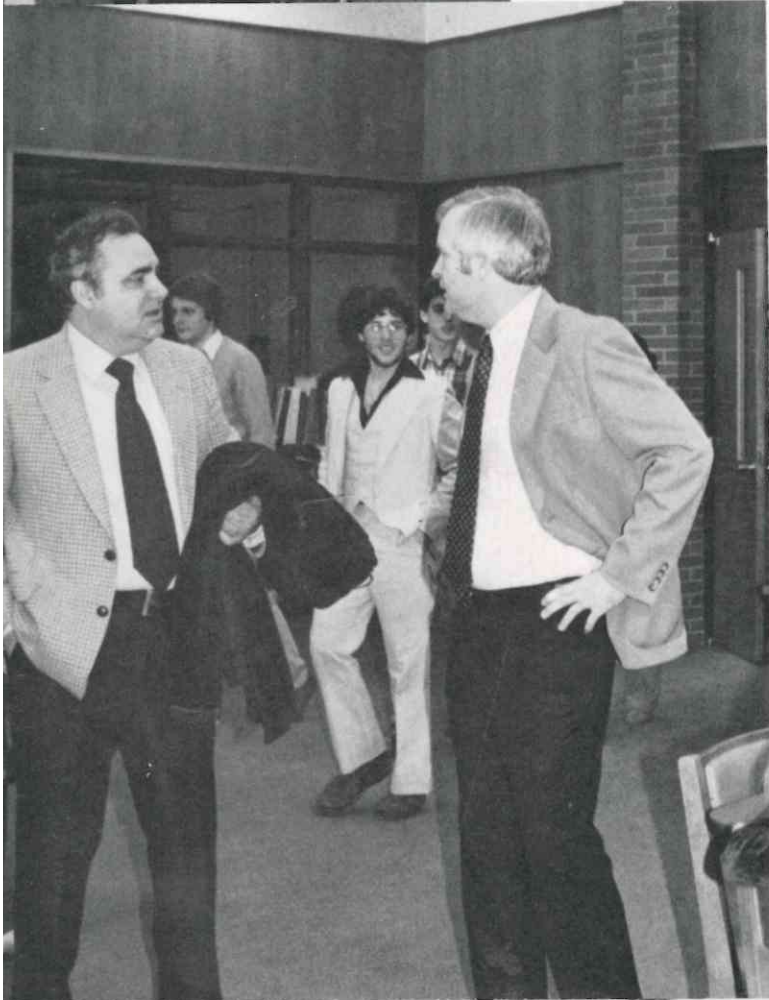




On March 14th and 15th the students of C.I. high went to Lake Placid to go skiing.
