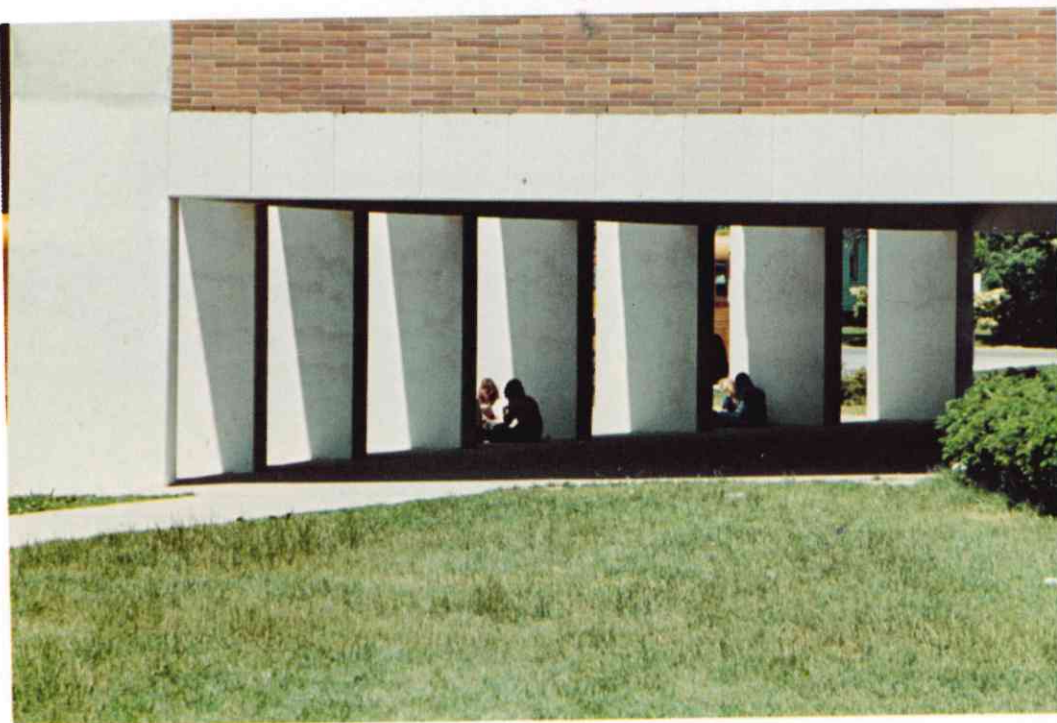






## *Building from the Past*

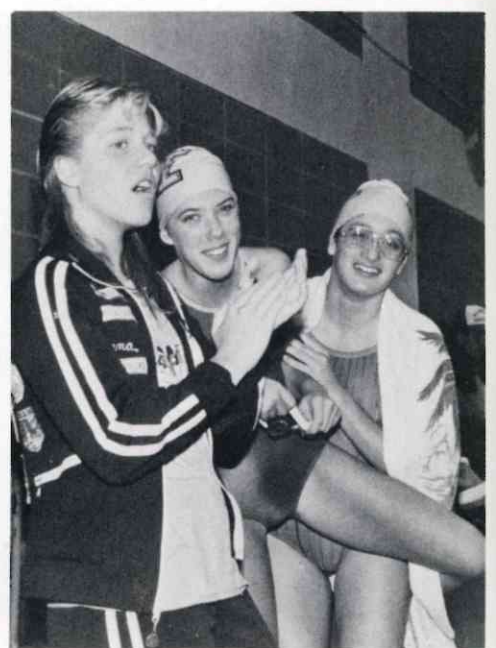
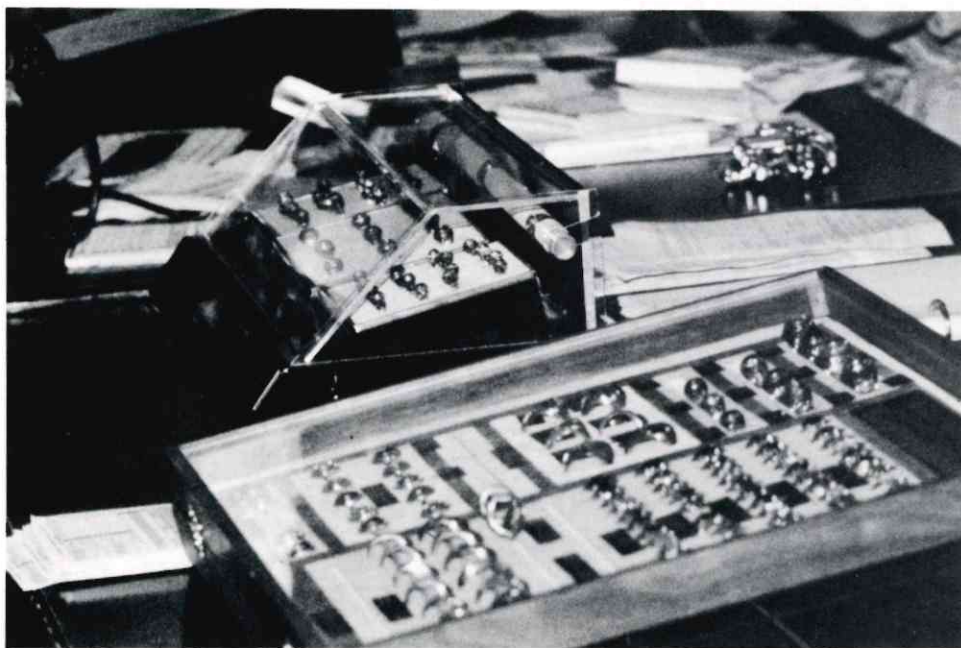

College Day is another important day. Colleges from all around came to show what they might have to offer some C.I. student. Parents were in to view college programs along with their children. Many students participated in this affair.













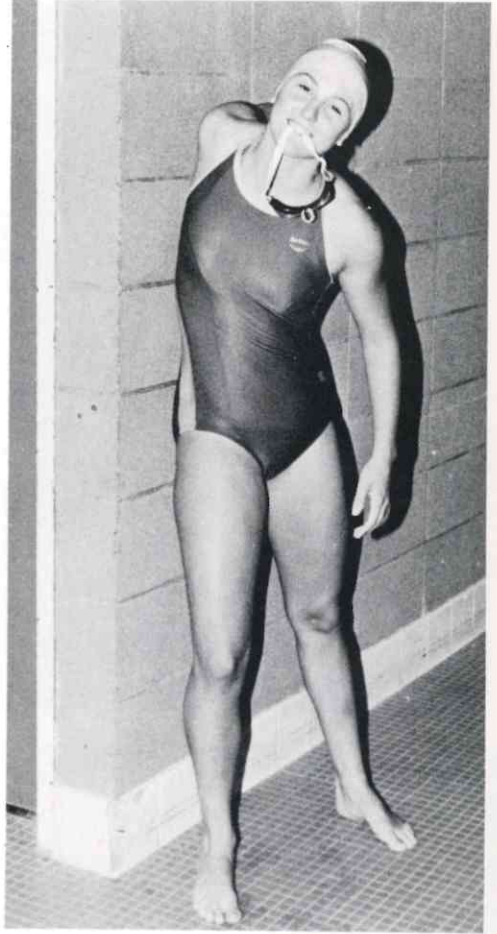
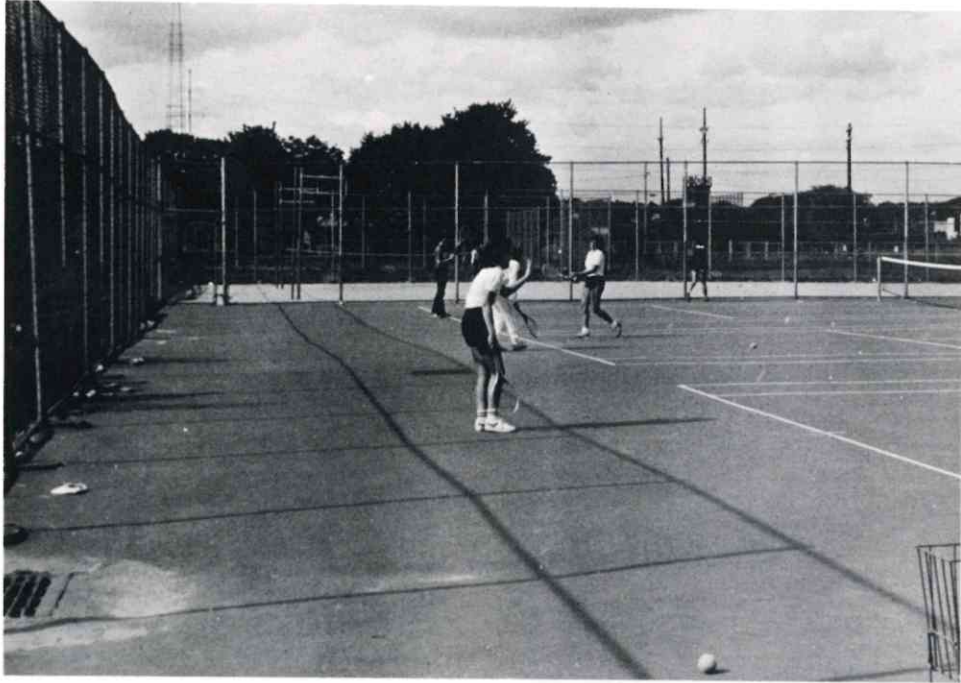
## *Building C.I. Spirit*

then went out and did some rousing cheers that really got the crowd going. All the teams were then announced. The C.I. fans were ready to start their sports season off right.













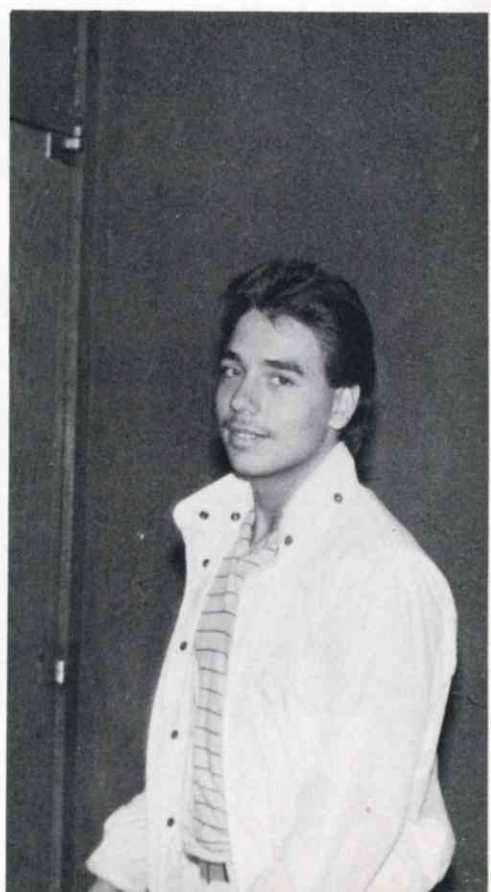




## *Building Friendships*
