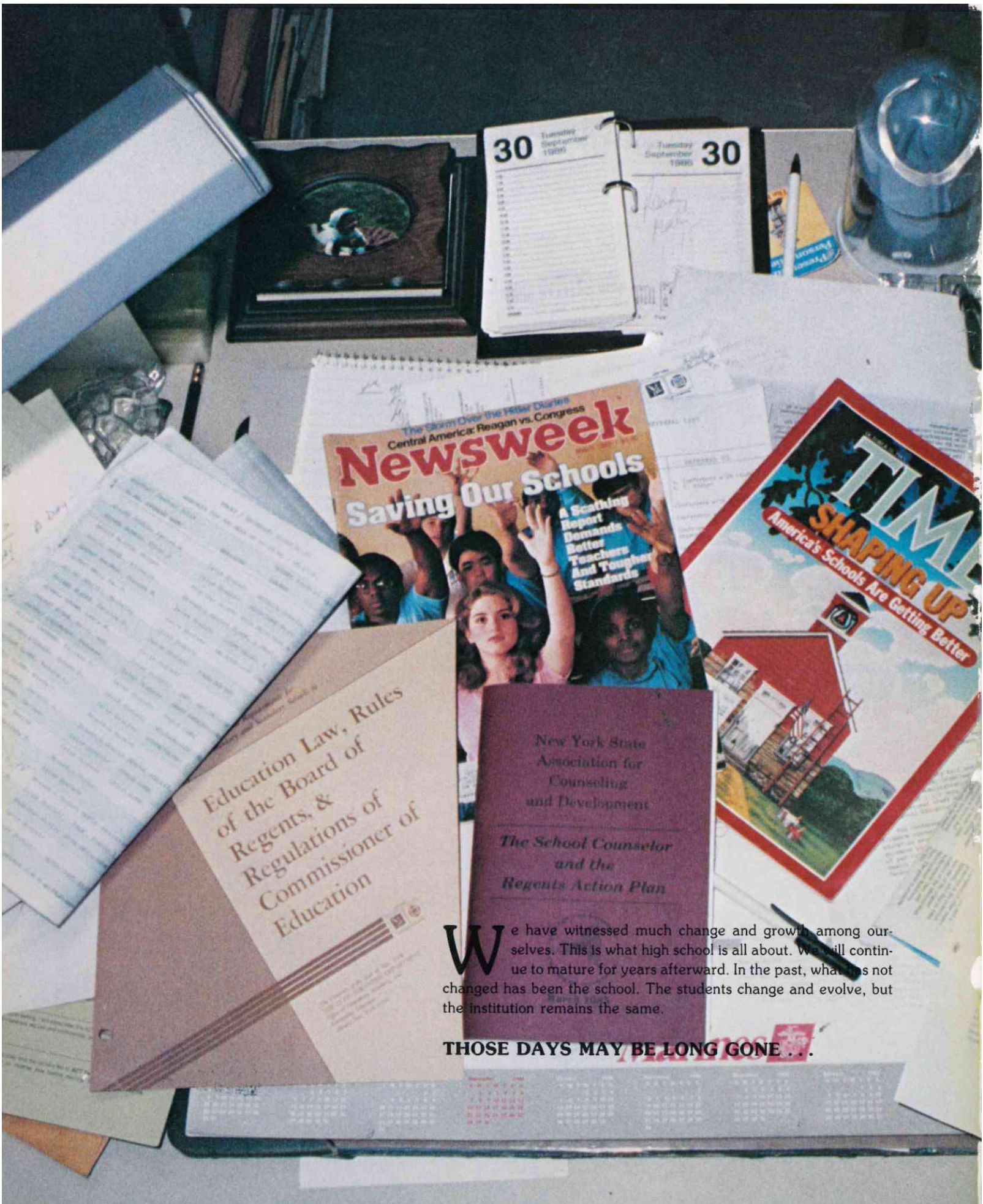
Coming, October 18, 1986

Donna Hippler, Robin Schaefer and Janine D'Aversa add to the teams winning efforts by compiling all of the games statistics.

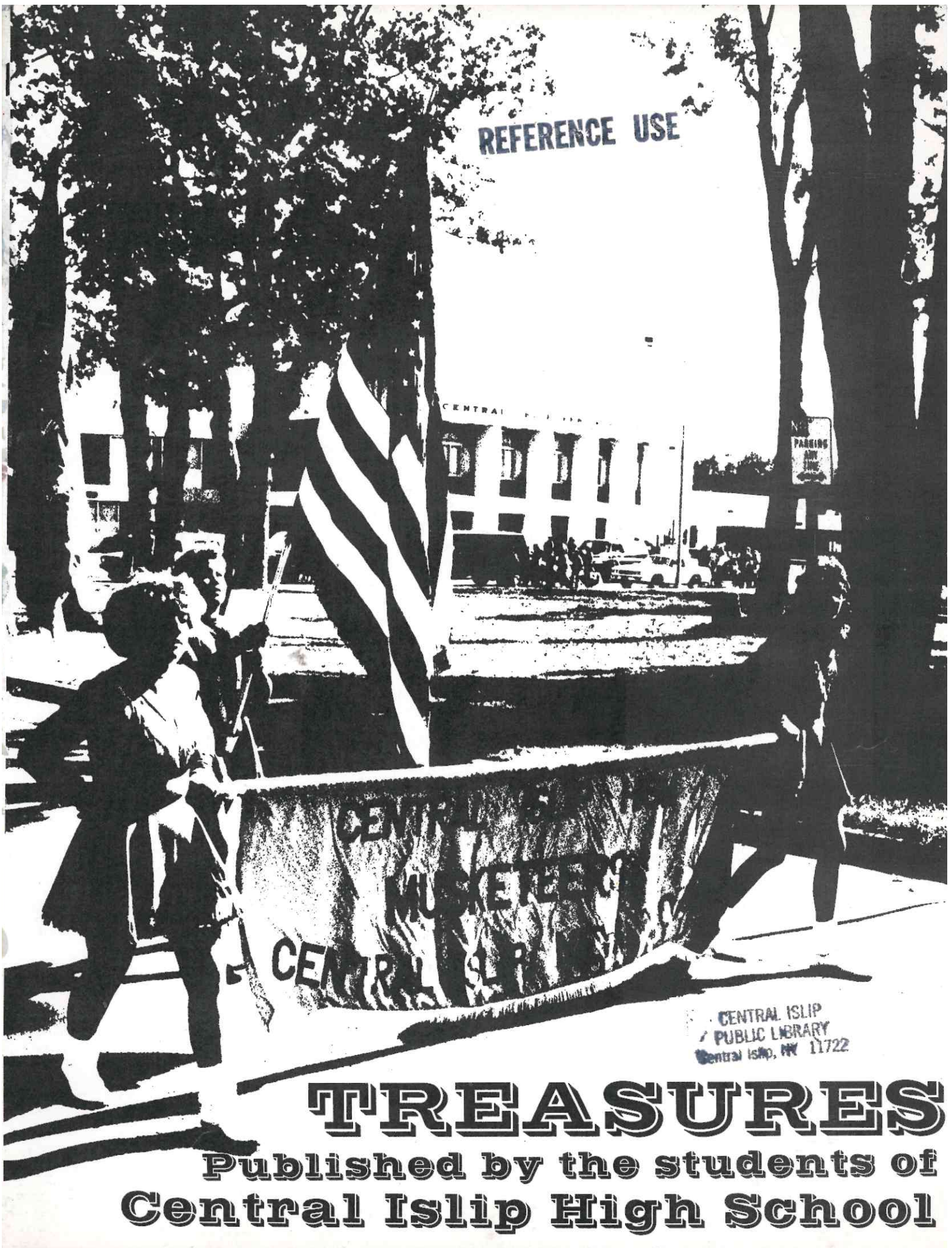

In November, Aviation/Aerospace Students visited the Grumman Aerospace facilities in Calverton. Mr. Dick Kupczyk hosted the tour which consisted of a slide presentation, films and a general look at the facilities. The students were shown the F-14 and A-6 production lines in addition to the E2C (radar planes) and the F-16. The students were each given a "first-hand" look at the F-14 cockpit.

The tour also consisted of a visit to the Anechoic Chamber where radar systems are tested and microwaves absorbed into a soundproof building. The automated Telemetry System was explained in detail as well as the giant Satellite Dish which immediately telemeters results of flight tests performed as far away as California.

The students were fascinated by the overwhelming complexity of the facilities and enjoyed themselves thoroughly.

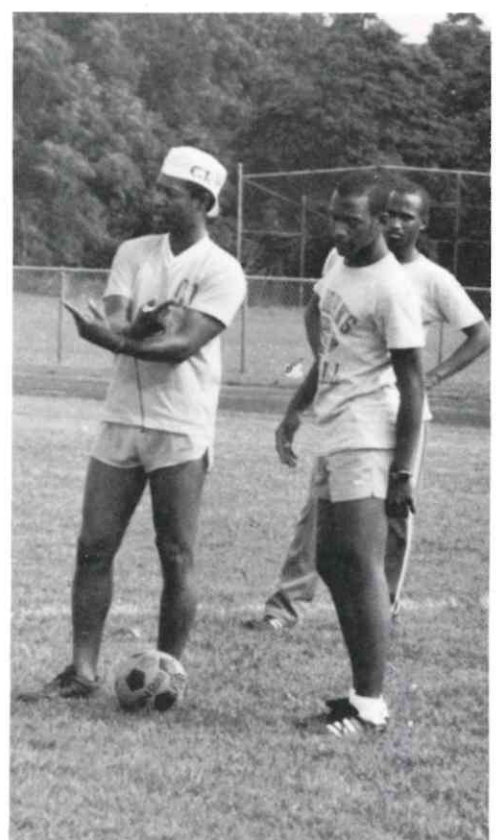


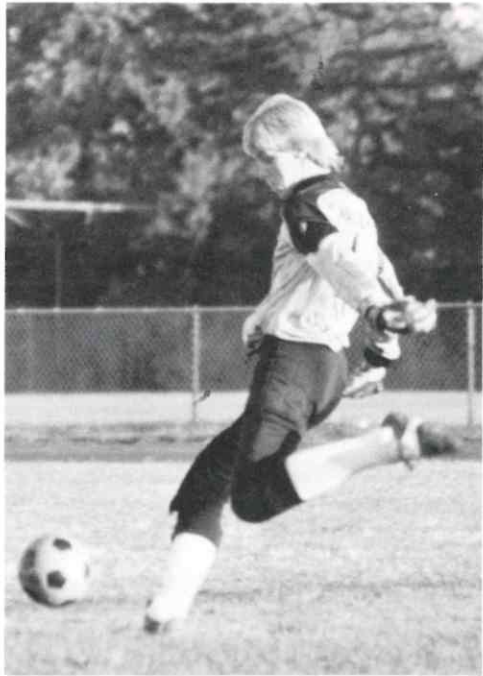
## **VARSITY SOCCER**

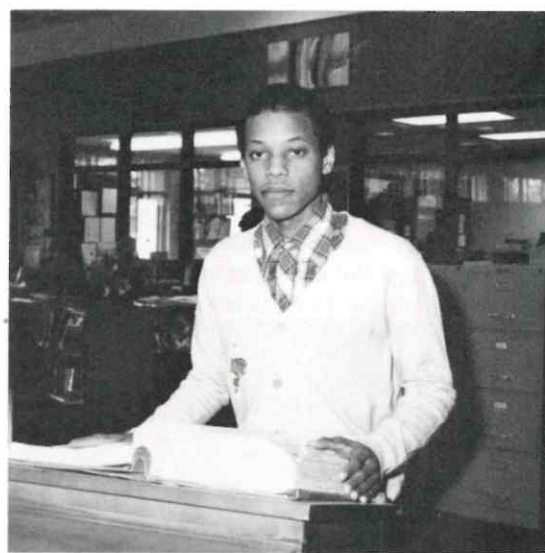


**Stacy Stallings:** "I think that this new plan will give students a chance to do better and to prepare for college and all of their future endeavors."

**Clayton Belmontes:** "Students have many advantages over the students of yesterday, and I believe that the Action Plan will help students to reach for their dreams."



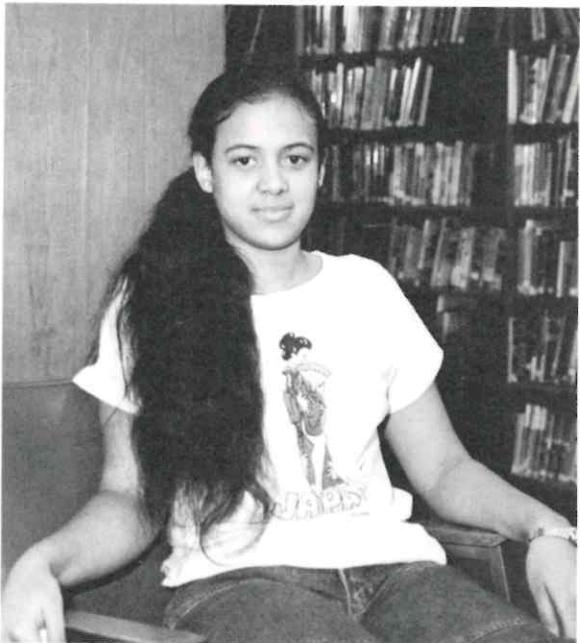
**Linda Merkel:** "The Action Plan is a definite step for the better. I hope it will put a dent in the problems of illiteracy in all school subjects."

**Christine Phillips:** "I think the Action Plan will help us more than we realize, and it will also help us to become better educated."





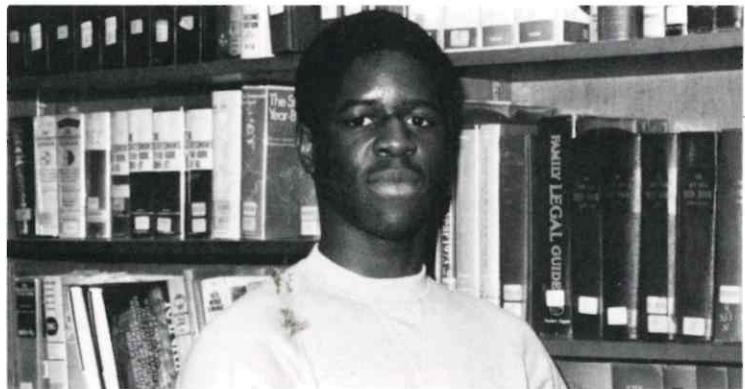
**Patrick Turner:** "I think that the new Action Plan is a great idea. This new plan will be beneficial to students who are willing to make their high school education work for them."

**John Smith:** The goal and theme of the Regents Action Plan seem to offer a sincere and sound educational program with just a slight problem regarding implementation. If the implementation problem is not resolved soon, I project fewer students receiving Regent Diplomas and, fewer students graduating during a regular four year high school program at Central Islip High School.



**Andrew McCaslin:** The new Regents Action Plan spells uncertainty, frustration and resentment for students and teachers alike. The term "accountability" will take on a whole new meaning. Students will find it difficult or impossible to re-learn poorly developed work habits and complacent attitudes toward school. The drop-out rate will increase and for some, high school will take five or six years to complete. Students might resent teachers demands of re-learning (for the first time) skills and concepts never taught. I am hopeful the Regents Committee gives us time to make the difficult adjustment before they react to the next wave of public Criticism.



**Joseph Elliffe:** I feel that we will not have too many students earning a regents diploma in the near future. Students are going to find the new requirement extreme difficult to cope with for many years to come. American students are not geared to the amount of work they now must do. It will take us many years to accomplish the goals set forth in the action plan. Students must begin the increased work load right in elementary schools. Proper study habits, greater reading ability and less time in front of a TV set must come forth.



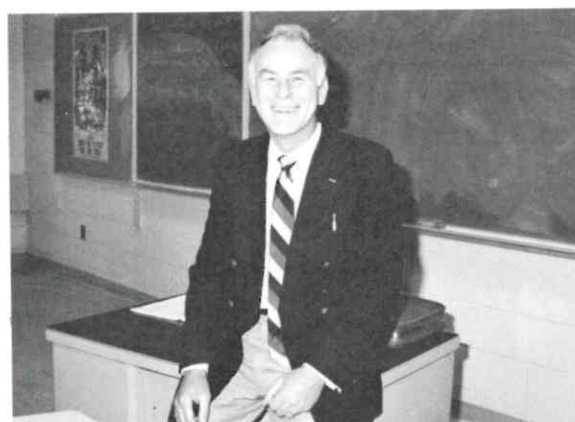
**Anthony Antonucci:** The Regents Action Plan will have a positive effect on education in Central Islip. I believe we will see a greater effort put forth by all, resulting in a better educational environment. However, the price for this improvement might be the failure of some to be willing and/or able to meet the requirements forcing the dropping out or the retirement of some presently involved in our educational process.



**Nancy Feinberg:** Due to the increase credit requirements, students will not have the time to take electives that can add to their overall knowledge. The Home Economics Department will see fewer regents tracked students who have Pre-set schedules courses such as Independent Living, Parenting, Family Living and Nutrition are life skills courses that every student can benefit from. One of the positive aspects of the Regents Action Plan for the Home Economics Department is revised and new curriculums.



**Lewis Miller:** "The inception of the Regents Action Plan requiring a second language, increasing the requirements in the mathematics and science areas will provide the students opting for a Regents diploma with a broader education than in the past. However, these increased requirements may discourage some students who would normally opt for a Regents diploma from seeking it. It is my opinion that the Regents Action Plan will have very little effect on education at Central Islip High School because the students who really want a Regents diploma will succeed in obtaining it."



**Cliff Rieser:** "I see the Regents Action Plan having both positive and negative effects on the students in Central Islip. Because of all the new academic requirements I see students getting a stronger overall education. However, because of these same requirements, I foresee a higher dropout rate and I see fewer students earning a regents diploma. I do believe it will be a few years before we can weigh the full affect of the Action Plan. Hopefully after students and parents fully realize the scope of this plan, it will become a positive one."



**Joan Kelley:** "Since the early 1960's a general attitude toward excellence not only in education but also in homelife and industry has declined rapidly. The accent has shifted to results only, with little or no emphasis on the means to attain these results. Hence, the statements, "How much money can I make doing the least amount of work?" or, "Let me receive the highest possible grade with the minimum amount of knowledge." The Regents Action Plan directly focuses on the discipline and hard work necessary to attain a coveted goal. It places greater demands on students and schools in a well defined and accurate set of requirements. I applaud this bold and necessary step."



**Donald Meehan:** "The Regents Action Plan will cause students to work harder and achieve more credits, the number being determined by the type of diploma, regents or non-regents. I feel this is good. However, I feel that as the Plan goes into effect, there will be certain results, both foreseen and unforeseen, that will dictate an evolutionary process to take place before the Plan reaches its final form."



**John Packard:** "I believe that the effect on education at Central Islip High School of the Regents Action Plan will be problematic. For the students that are willing to work hard, they will have acquired a high school education that could stand with some of the best in the country. However, I worry that many students will not realize what is required of them until the time is too late. They may need 5 years, if they ever get their high school diploma."





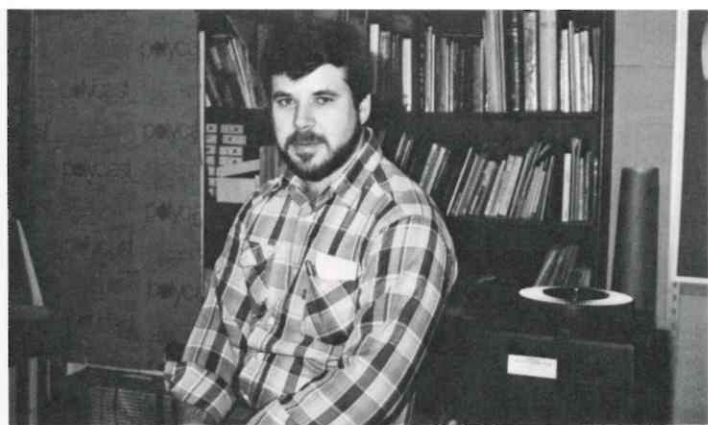
**Michael Moore:** If America is to keep pace with the other major industrial nations of the world, our schools must better prepare our students for the demands which will be placed upon them. 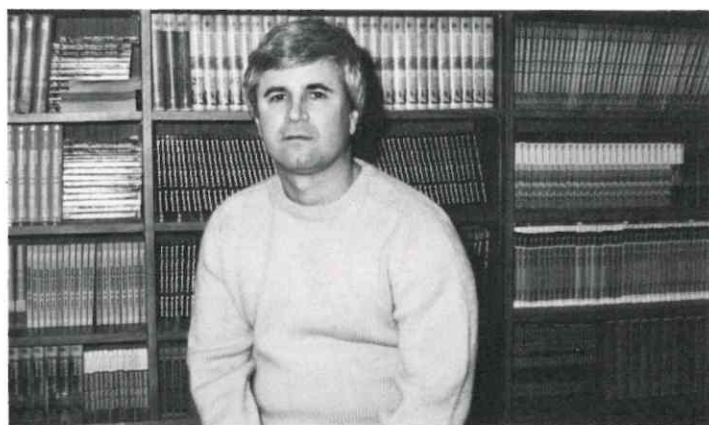
**Carlton E. Johnson:** I feel that the Regents Action Plan will have a very positive effect on the education of Central Islip High School students. It will return "academics" to the high school curriculum by placing a greater emphasis on challenging students to make the most of their education. In general, I think the attempt on the part of the New York State Board of Regents to upgrade verbal and written skills by introducing this Action Plan is a definite step in the right direction toward helping students meet the challenges of the 21st century.



**Carlis Hawker:** "In Industrial Technology, we are no longer going to make "projects" as we have in the past. The Regents Action Plan wants the student to have a "daily experience" and not go into an in depth study of a subject area. The concept is sound but . . . Many students are failing their classes due to attendance problems not because they can not do the work. These students will have problems meeting the new requirements for graduation under the Regents Action Plan."



**Lawrence Nagy:** I feel that the Regents Action Plan will have a positive effect on education at C.I.H.S. by increasing graduation requirements students will be required to take courses they may not have been otherwise exposed to. This exposure to a more varied curriculum will better introduce students to future career opportunities and vocational interests. Hopefully it will also better prepare students to be more cultured, well-rounded and productive citizens.



**William Schiavo:** If the Regents Action Plan will truly raise academic standards, then I believe it will affect Central Islip students in a beneficial way. Robert Browning may be correct when he states that "A man's reach should exceed his grasp, or what's a Haven for?" Students are almost always better served when they must rise to an intellectual challenge.





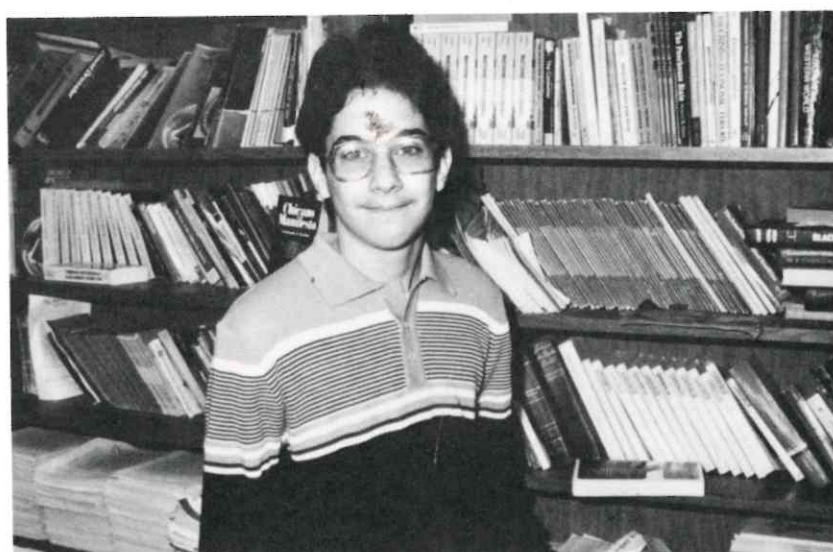
