## TODAY . . .



# DEDICATION



people from all over the United States put Perot on the ballot and the battlelines were drawn for the presidency of the United States.



## Looking Back at 1992-93

Other events also took center stage during the year. In April, the acquittal of the policemen involved in the beating of Rodney King led to chaotic riots in Los Angeles and other urban areas in the United States. The riots caused damage that cost \$785 million dollars and resulted in 52 deaths, 2,883 injuries, and 18,807 arrests.

In August, Hurricane Andrew devastated South Florida with a powerhouse intensity before moving into Louisiana. The hurricane's 54-hour rampage was the most expensive natural disaster to hit this country that caused an estimated 180,000 homeless in Florida alone. At least 51 deaths were directly attributed to the storm. The damage cost approximately \$22 billion dollars.

Hurricane Iniki dealt a direct blow to part of the Hawaiian Islands in September. Winds gusting up to 160 mph and torrential rain hit Kauai Island, causing enormous damage. It was the most powerful hurricane to hit the Hawaiian Islands this century. Twenty-foot waves crashed coastal highways and the island lost all power and telephone service even before the worst of the storm hit. Oahu, the state's most populated island with a 800,000 people, is separated from Kauai by a 80-mile channel and was spared the brunt of the storm.

In sports, Larry, Michael, and Magic led the Dream Team to gold during the Summer Olympics in Barcelona. The Olympics marked the end of the careers of Larry Bird and Ervin "Magic" Johnson, who revitalized the NBA 13 years ago. The United States gained 108 medals during the Summer Olympics that were participated by a record 10,000 athletes from 183 countries.

After a long six months, the Boys of Summer concluded the Major League Baseball season with the World Series. The Atlanta Braves repeated as National League Champions by defeating the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Toronto Blue Jays became the first team from Canada to participate in the World Series by defeating Oakland Athletics in the American League Championship Series. In the World Series, Toronto defeated Atlanta to bring the championship crown north of the border.

Super Bowl XXVII was held in Pasadena, California, and the Dallas Cowboys defeated the Buffalo Bills, ignominiously giving the Bills its third consecutive Super Bowl defeat.








Focus On ...


## Working Hard

Some of their goals that they have accomplished for this season were to rebuild the C.I. wrestling team and get the team familiar with the new coaching staff.








# Last Chances


Ludell Fils-Amie
